







~230K people live in the Lepelle-Nkumpi municipality; Lebowakgomo is the seat of the region







Only 50km from Polokwane, Lebowakgomo is an important labour source for Polokwane; there are many migrant workers



Sepedi is the most commonly-spoken language in the area




Primary language spoken





LANGUAGE: % SEPEDI SPEAKERS







Although average income in the region is low (~R1,100 ppp month*), aggregated monthly income is sizeable (~R242M)



Monthly income breakdown (by # of people)




% OF PEOPLE WITH INCOME > R12.8K / MONTH





In addition to salary, ~2.1M people in Limpopo (~61% of households) receive social grants*, providing extra income






Types of grants (# of national recipients, monthly payment):

- 1. Grants for older persons (~3M, ~R1,350)
- 2. Disability grant (~1.1M, ~R1,350)
- 3. War veteran's grant (**373**, ~**R1**,**370**)
- 4. Foster child grant (**~548K**, **~R830**)
- 5. Care dependency grant (123K, ~R1,350)
- 6. Child support grant (11.5K, ~R320)
- 7. Grant in-aid (~94K, ~R320)
- 8. Social relief of distress (varies, ~R1,350)

Remittances = money sent back home for the family to use








Lebowakgomo portrait, municipality entrance
