



Phuthaditjhaba (formerly Qwaqwa / Witsieshoek) is a bustling town in the Free State, bordering KZN and Lesotho



There is a wide variety of shops within these malls, including:





































Tourism is an important sector for the region: the Drakensberg straddles Phuthaditjhaba's western border






Sesotho is the most commonly-spoken language in the area





Although average income in the region is low (~R890 ppp month*), aggregated monthly income is sizeable (~R110M)




% OF PEOPLE WITH INCOME > R12.8K / MONTH





In addition to salary, ~900K people in Free State (55% of households) receive social grants*, providing extra income






Types of grants (# of national recipients, monthly payment):

- Grants for older persons (~3M, ~R1,350)
- 2. Disability grant (~1.1M, ~R1,350)
- 3. War veteran's grant (**373**, ~**R1**,**370**)
- 4. Foster child grant (**~548K**, **~R830**)
- 5. Care dependency grant (123K, ~R1,350)
- 6. Child support grant (11.5K, ~R320)
- 7. Grant in-aid (~94K, ~R320)
- 8. Social relief of distress (varies, ~R1,350)

Remittances = money sent back home for the family to use




